

NEW MEXICO'S MEDICAID TRANSITION PREMIUM RELIEF PROGRAM ON BEWELLMN.COM

During the pandemic, states could not disenroll people from Medicaid. Now, New Mexicans enrolled in Medicaid will need to renew their coverage when notified by the Human Services Department (HSD) to stay enrolled.

Here's what you can do to stay covered:

1. Update your contact information with HSD today.
2. Watch for your **Turquoise** envelope when it's time to renew. If you have signed up for HSD electronic notices, watch for email or text updates.
3. Complete your renewal application at yes.state.nm.us and click "Renew My Benefits."



If you learn you no longer qualify for Medicaid, you can stay covered by seeing if you can get health insurance through your job or your spouse/parent's job. If you can't get affordable coverage through a job, you likely qualify for a low- or no-cost health plan on beWellnm.com, New Mexico's Health Insurance Marketplace.



MEDICAID TRANSITION PREMIUM RELIEF PROGRAM

Financial help is available on beWellnm.com. Through the *Medicaid Transition Premium Relief Program* the first month's premium may be paid for most people moving from Medicaid to [beWellnm](https://beWellnm.com).

The program is meant to minimize coverage disruptions and lock-in consumer protections for qualifying individuals and families who need affordable coverage. This program is **only** available through beWellnm.com.

DO I QUALIFY FOR THE PROGRAM ?

To qualify for the *Medicaid Transition Premium Relief Program*, you must:

- be a State of New Mexico resident;
- no longer qualify for full coverage Medicaid;
- qualify for Federal Premium Tax Credits; and
- be in a household that makes less than the **annual** income amount in the table below

Family Size	If you make less than:
